**The Waste (England and Wales) Regulations 2011 - changes required to Waste Transfer Notes.**

As from 28th September, the new Waste Regulations 2011 will require that 2 additional pieces of information are present on all waste transfer notes. From this date, all transfer notes must contain:

- 1) A declaration confirming that businesses have applied the waste management hierarchy.
- 2) The waste producer's Standard Industrial Classification (SIC) code.
